Dear Parent,

In Literacy, the children have listened to the story of 'Noah's Ark' which linked to the number work on sorting and matching. The children also enjoyed a story, 'What Makes a Rainbow?' and completed pencil control and colour mixing activities based on this.

In Phonics, the children have listened carefully to household sounds and tried to identify different noises. The hardest one was the sound of creaky stairs! The children played a game of Sound Bingo, have continued to work on identifying the initial sound of their names and have started to listen to the initial sound of other words, enjoying a game called 'Sound Soup'.

In Mathematics, we have continued to focus on counting and sorting skills. The children have completed tasks involving the numerals 1 and 2, including recognition and matching activities. We thought about all the body parts we have two of, such as eyes and ears and enjoyed playing with the Noah's Ark and pairing up the animals.

Please note:

If you are picking your child up after lunch at 1.10pm, please could we ask that you now pick up at 1.15pm, and wait outside the main gate. We will then bring the children to the gate for you at 1.15pm. This will avoid children getting upset in the playground when they see parents arriving.
