#### **Tests**

Monday – Spellings

**Tuesday** – Times Tables (focus on 2, 5, 10s) a new focus to get the children in school fast with table responses as they complete TT Rockstars.

**Wednesday** – Mental Maths

**Monday** – we have started the week with our phonics lesson, please keep revisiting sounds from level 5 as I noticed that some children are less confident with some of these. We went onto start looking at place value using our new maths scheme 'White Rose'. In the afternoon we had the Hook day reveal and thinking about the start of our new topic 'Beachcombers'.

**Tuesday** – we travelled to Scarbrough, Sealife centre. The children and staff had a fantastic day despite the wet weather. The children were given so many hands-on experiences including the interactive Rockpools and watching the sharks and rays being fed. The children were so well behaved and looked really smart in their P.E kits.

**Wednesday**- another exciting day for the whole school – Rockstars are entered school for a morning of times table games and activities. Thank you to Mr Mullis for setting us up with log in details for TT Rockstars. In the afternoon the children performed dances to 'We Will Rock You' with Miss Suggitt.

**Thursday**- The children enjoyed their French lessons with Madam Pickford. They are learning how to say hello in different languages and have learnt a song which teaches how people say hello in different countries. In the afternoon we write an account of our trip to The Sealife centre.
