Tests

Monday - Spellings

Tuesday – Times Tables (focus on 2, 5, 10s) this test will include division as well.

Wednesday – Mental Maths (Times tables, number bonds and place value)

Monday – the week started with a spelling test, which were tricky but the children were ready and eager for the tests to start again. Afterwards we completed some further work on place value looking at some practical maths using equipment to make numbers such as 62 etc. The children completed a maths activity and found some of the wording confusing at first. In the afternoon we started to design our sea creature in DT.

Tuesday – the children completed a timetables test after a quick game of random times tables questions, where they scored points for their tables. In English the children started to write a story plan for their story all about their sea creature. We looked at how stories are structured with a beginning, middle and end. In the afternoon the needles and threads came out and we have some eager sewers in Remove.

Wednesday- the day started with a split computer and music lesson followed by some handwriting practice. We need to encourage children to sit correctly with a good posture and hold their pencils correctly. Harvest Festival songs are in full swing. This afternoon the children had an exciting P.E lesson with Miss Suggitt.

Thursday- it was lovely to hear the children singing in French and a child corrected me by saying it is Madam Pickford for French not Mrs Pickford! We have continued with TT Rockstars and work on place value. This afternoon we looked at leaders of different faiths.

Friday – the children had an active P.E lesson with Mr Heseltine today followed by a phonics lesson. This afternoon we continued with our sewing.
