Here's a glimpse into what your children have been exploring in school this week.

In English, our grammar focus was on the use of coordinating and subordinating conjunctions. The children showcased their growing understanding of sentence structure by creating their own sentences using these essential language elements. Additionally, we have continued our class text of 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory', with the children writing character descriptions of their favourite characters.

In Mathematics, we have looked at number complements up to 100 and continued refining our column method for the subtraction of 3-digit and 2-digit numbers.

In Science, we explored different diets such as pescatarian, vegan, omnivorous, and vegetarian, which provided valuable insights into various dietary choices and their impacts. The engaging discussions reflected the children's curiosity and understanding of the importance of healthy eating.

In Art, the children embraced their creative side, crafting fantastic masks inspired by the ancient Maya culture.

Meanwhile, in History, we explored Chichen Itza, the famous Aztec city temple, and one of the seven wonders of the world.

In PSHE, we tackled the important theme of understanding that differences and conflicts sometimes happen and the children engaged in discussions about effective problem-solving strategies.
