Form III thoroughly enjoyed visiting Harewood House on Wednesday. The volunteers gave us a really warm welcome and appreciated everyone's respectful energy and enthusiasm.

On Monday, Dr Hinchcliffe, the Headmaster of Bradford Grammar, helped launch anti-bullying week. He gave us a thought-provoking assembly and even embraced our 'odd socks' day by wearing a vibrant pair of mismatching socks. On Thursday, Form I gave us an entertaining assembly and some of the class enjoyed the FPTA disco. Finally, on Friday, all the children came to school in home clothes.

We have had a busy week of classwork too. In History, we looked at the four claimants to the English throne in the year 1066. In English, we continued to work on our Titanic diaries and revisited different types of clauses – main, subordinate and relative.

Main clause: a complete sentence on its own with a subject and a verb.

Subordinate clause: a clause that depends on the main clause and doesn't make sense on its own.

Relative clause: a clause that modifies a noun or a pronoun and starts with a relative pronoun, such as who, whom, whose, which, that.

In Maths, we looked at checking our calculations using the inverse operation; improper fractions as well as mixed numbers. The children had a brief introduction to multiplying fractions as it cropped up in our mental maths test. During our starters, we have revisited key skills such as: squared numbers, perimeter and area. In our Science lesson, we looked at gears, pulleys and levers. Our next Science topic will be Space.

I have been incredibly pleased by the enthusiasm of some children to try and reach the monthly reading target of four books. This will certainly improve their reading skills. A few children have already read a favourite of mine, 'The Secret Garden'! Keep this up!
