This week the children were really excited to tell us all about the exciting things over half term, Halloween and Bonfire Night! It sounds like they had a great time. As tomorrow is Remembrance Day, we have been talking about what that means. On Thursday we held a Remembrance service outside. Mrs Coulson spoke and some Form IV'S read a poem and Mrs Jones played The Last Post whilst the flag was lowered. I was so proud of the children standing silently and listening so well.

Literacy

This week, we have been recapping all of the letters in Phase 2. We have been reading words with these sounds and trying to form the letters using the rhymes. See if your child can practise some letter formation at home and use the cards to make words and write them.

We have now finished the Phase 2 sounds and next week, we will be moving on to Phase 3!

Mathematics

This week, we have been comparing lots of circles and triangles. We looked at positional language such as in, on, under, over, behind, in front of, around, through and beside etc. We then went around the school using the appropriate language to spot things.

We then have moved on to finding different representations of 4 and 5, looking at different ways of finding 4 and 5. Then we moved onto instantly recognising the number of objects or items in a group without needing to count them.

Homework

All homework will be set on the Seesaw app. Practice working through activities on the tricky words from Phase 2.

Please practise reading, flashcards and Tricky Word bookmarks and spelling these at home.
