On Thursday we were treated to an amazing assembly on Children in Need by Form I. Thank you for your kind donations. We have started to practise learning our songs for the Nativity! We are so excited for you to come and watch them!

Literacy

This week, we have been learning the sounds j, v w and x. We have been reading words with these sounds and trying to form the letters using the rhymes. See if your child can practise some letter formation at home:

- j – down the jet, around its trail, dot for the sun
- v – down the neck, up the neck
- w – down the wave, up the wave, down the wave, up the wave
- x – criss, cross

Next week we will start to learn some digraphs (two letters making one sound).

Mathematics

This week, we have been exploring finding different representations of 4 and 5. They built on their learning from this to create their own representations of 4 and 5 using different objects. We then introduced the concept of 1 more, working with numbers up to 5.

Homework

All homework will be set on the Seesaw app. This week, the focus is performing a Nursery Rhyme! We are looking forward to hearing them and sharing them with the class!

Also, I have attached a letter formation sheet to practice.

Your child will also bring home some new flashcards along with a Tricky Word bookmark. Please practise reading and spelling these at home.
