#### **English**

This week in English, the children have continued reading more chapters of our class novel 'The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane'. We have been looking at the punctuation used in the novel and tried to replicate it in our diary writing. This week we looked at apostrophes for contraction and time connectives. Form I were extremely focused when we read the chapters about Sarah Jane dying and then Edward collapsing.

#### Maths

In Mathematics the children have continued the area of learning 'Length and Perimeter'. They have applied their learning to solve word problems.

We are continuing our differentiated Mental Arithmetic booklets and these will be sent home today. Please review and work on any corrections, thank you. From your starred work we have worked on time. Please use the glossary sent home to help with the Mathematical terminology. Miss Hazel and I are continuing to work with these groups. From next week, we will be working on time in our Early Morning Flashback Activities.

#### Science

We have continued our topic on 'Light'. We looked into reflective surfaces and the children know what reflection is and can identify reflective surfaces. They selected the correct reflective material for a particular purpose.

# **Global Studies**

This week the children started their history work on Ancient Egypt. They pointed out where Egypt is on a map and discussed when the ancient Egyptians lived. We also looked at some artefacts. The children raised questions about the artefacts and decided how they may have been used.
