# FIV's Snapshot of The Week:

What a busy end to the Spring Term!

There have been many highlights this week, including the fiercely contested House General Knowledge Quiz and the chance to take part in and watch the Spring Festival Competition classes. Well done to everyone for taking part so admirably in these important annual events! We are sure you are proud of your talented children.

The Enterprise Challenge has been a huge success, with over £250 profit raised from the first two days of sales alone! Once the children cash up and complete their sponsored events, we will have a final total. We have been very impressed with the way that they have tackled this project.

# **Tests and Folders:**

The test folders are coming home this weekend so please ensure corrections are completed and the folders are sent back in after the Easter break. The children have new spellings to learn and Spelling Writing to complete over the holiday.

### Show Auditions:

The auditions for the show have been split into two categories – acting and singing. The children all did brilliantly in their acting audition last week. We used the Drama Festival Class as their acting audition. The singing audition will take place on Wednesday 17 April. The children are expected to prepare one of the songs from the show. All the songs are on Seesaw and the children should learn the one they want to perform for the audition. We are expecting them to put their own actions or movements to the song they have chosen for their audition. Mrs Jones has suggested to each child the range of songs which suits their voice the best. If the song they want to sing is not in their key, Mrs Jones suggests that they practise without the backing track.

In addition to this, please encourage the children to listen to the full soundtrack several times in the holidays and sing along with the words from their script.

# Sponsored Event:

The children are bringing home a sponsor form for the Enterprise Team Sponsored Challenge. The money raised for this will be split between pocket money for The French Trip and our School Charity, Water Aid. Collectively, we are aiming to raise £900, so £450 can be added to our Water Aid total and £450 can be added to the total raised so far from the Business ventures.
