It was so lovely celebrating World Book Day yesterday. We had some very creative costume ideas. As a class we looked at the story of George's Marvellous Medicine. We had a very action-packed day with activities ranging from a book swap to creating their own medicines.

Timetables – Most children are learning the nine times table in random order. Once these are learnt they can move onto the four times table. Please continue to refer to the rocket tracker, to keep a track on the time table they need to work on that week. **Times table test next week.**

In English we have continued with work on the Class Book 'Hodgeheg', thinking about Max's muddled speech after a knock to the head. The children have been looking at the present/past tense in phonics and looking at the spelling patterns. The children enjoyed sharing their books they wrote with Kindergarten today.

In Maths we have started our new focus on multiplication and division. The children had to discuss equal and unequal groups. We looked at adding equal groups e.g. Kim has 20p. How many 10p coins could she have? How many 5p coins could she have?

In the Connective Curriculum we have been learning about the RNLI (The Royal National Lifeboat Institution). The children wrote about it, and we watched Barnaby Bear at the Seaside and a real-life rescue when some children drifted out to sea in their dingy.
