In English we have been working on our writing skills, writing less but concentrating on details and making the piece of writing interesting. In phonics we have been looking at commands and questions in level 6 and plurals in level 5.

In Maths we have been focusing on dividing by two and looking at odd and even numbers both in written and practical tasks. We are encouraging the children to share the different strategies with each other, this can be a tricky skill to grasp.

Homework – this weekend the children have been asked to complete a reading comprehension all about hedgehogs. Encourage children to read the text and see if they can answer the questions independently – some help may be needed.
