Dear Parents

We hope you had a wonderful Easter holiday, it has been so lovely to hear the children's stories and look at all the photos of their adventures. We can't believe the weather we have had this week. I think we had all the seasons in one day!!! We have started to practise for our class assembly which will take place on Wednesday 22nd May 2024. I'm sure the children will be keen to share the songs with you!

Literacy

This week we have been learning to read words with adjacent consonants e.g. milk. We have been writing these too, see if your child can do this at home.

Next week we will continue with Phase 4. This phase incorporates consonant blends such as br (as in brown) or str (as in street). Phase 4 really helps with reading fluency and you may notice your child becomes more fluent in their reading as we go through the phase.

Mathematics

This week we have been looking at doubling numbers. We have explored length and height. We found sticks around the playground and sorted them into short lengths and long lengths. They enjoyed going around the school looking at how high things were, compared with taller and shorter things.

Homework

All homework will be set on the Seesaw app. Please check the app for this week's activities. They can discuss with you where they have been in the world and the UK. They can record it on Seesaw or write it down. Next week we will look at the UK and World Map and try to locate them.

Your child will also bring home some sound mats, containing all of the Level 2 & 3 sounds we have learnt. They have also got a mat of all of the tricky words in phase 2, 3 and 4. You can use these as a recap at home or play some games with them e.g. spot the sound.

There will also be some spellings for children to practise at home. There will not be a formal spelling test but this is good practise for the children when they move up to Transition next year. It will teach spelling patterns and we will use these in our writing throughout the week.
