We have had a lovely second week of the term and have continued to enjoy the focus on Space. We have learnt about the different things you find in space, and looked at the planets, the moon, the sun and the stars.

In Mathematics this week, we reinforced shape with the children creating a rocket picture using different shapes. We also continued to count back from five using a variety of games and songs. We used the game 'Who stole the Cookie from the Cookie Shop' to reinforce number recognition and placing numbers in the correct place on a number line.

In Literacy the children have enjoyed Floppy the dog, helping them reinforce letter recognition and formation. Some children are confident working on letter formation and for some children we are working on pencil control.

The children thoroughly enjoyed the games session this week; we were pretending to be astronauts blasting off to the moon and then walking and jumping on the moon. The session finished with a game of 'Crazy Dodgeball' which was a request from the children!
